Job Description:	General Counselor
Free Time:	Rest Hour 1:00 PM – 2:30 PM (As scheduled with Co-counselors) Free period daily as assigned in personal schedule
Day Off:	Once Weekly as Assigned

Requirements for General Counselor Position:

- Experience working with children with additional needs
- Excellent interpersonal skills. Camp counselors must be able to establish trust and rapport, and to set healthy boundaries in their work with our campers
- Excellent organizational skills, communication skills, and a passion for interacting with individuals who have special needs

Job Description:

General Counselors live in bunks with their campers. They go to activities with the campers, eat meals with their group and are responsible for the campers' safety, social and emotional well-being at all times.

General Counselors need to be very comfortable living in a group environment. Staff will need to be able to work in a team of 3 or 4 co-counselors, and keep the bunk neat and organized at all times so the campers can be as independent as possible.

Counselors must also be comfortable working on daily living skills with the campers (showering, dressing, teeth brushing, etc . . .) Staff must have patience, energy, and the ability to see the best in every camper. We want our campers to have a great summer, but we also want them to grow and learn new skills.

General Counselors must be comfortable taking part in all activities, sports, arts & crafts and special events with their campers. Staff will also be expected to be a part of all camp shows and counselors' entertainment.
