Job Description: Arts and Crafts Specialist (Counselor)

Requirements for Arts and Crafts Specialist Position:

- Classroom or group experience teaching arts and crafts to children (pre-school/nursery school, school for children with additional needs, Rainbow/Scout/Brownie Troops, etc.)
- Experience working with children who have different abilities. Experience presenting a class project, so all campers can participate to the best of their ability.
- A background in arts and crafts and a flare for being creative.
- Excellent organizational skills and a passion for interacting with individuals who have special needs.

Job Description:

Each summer two arts and crafts specialists are hired at Camp Lee Mar. Each specialist will have their own art room which needs to be kept organized. The two art coordinators work together to plan a six week art and crafts program for the campers. Campers have two art sessions per week. It is the arts and crafts specialists responsible for making sure that the craft room is kept neat and clean, with all appropriate items locked away at the end of the day.

Arts and crafts specialists will also be responsible for creating any needed projects, props or backdrops for the end of season camp show or senior prom

Be available to arrive at camp three days before staff orientation to inventory supplies and plan the program in order to determine what supplies will be required for the summer. Place a full arts and crafts order with the assistant director to cover all items needed for classes.

Arts and Crafts Specialists live in bunks with their campers. They eat meals with their group, and are responsible for the campers' safety, as well as their social and emotional well-being. Counselors must be comfortable living in a group environment and be comfortable working on daily living skills with the campers (showering, dressing, brushing teeth, etc.) Counselors must have patience, energy, and the ability to see the best in every camper. We want our campers to have a great summer, but we also want them to grow and learn new skills. Counselors need to be able to work in a team with 3 or 4 co-counselors and keep the bunk neat and organized at all times so the campers can be as independent as possible.
