Job Description: Pool Staff - Lifeguard (Counselor)

Requirements for Pool Staff/Lifeguard Position:

- Experience working at a pool teaching or lifeguarding
- Have obtained the American Lifeguard Certification or overseas equivalent (National Pool Lifeguard Qualification, Austswim, etc.)
- Experience enforcing pool rules and keeping pool area organized and free of hazards
- Excellent organizational skills and a passion for interacting with individuals who have special needs

Job Description:

Pool Staff - Lifeguards are responsible for the safe day to day running of the pool. Pool staff must be confident in communicating and enforcing pool regulations and rules in a personable and professional manner. Pool staff must also communicate any needed areas of repair to the facility to the director. Additionally, all pool staff will be responsible for ensuring campers are receiving level appropriate swim instruction in the water.

Pool Staff - Lifeguards live in bunks with their campers. They eat meals with their group, and are responsible for the campers' safety, as well as their social and emotional well-being. Counselors must be comfortable living in a group environment and be comfortable working on daily living skills with the campers (showering, dressing, brushing teeth, etc.) Counselors must have patience, energy, and the ability to see the best in every camper. We want our campers to have a great summer, but we also want them to grow and learn new skills. Counselors need to be able to work in a team with 3 or 4 co-counselors and keep the bunk neat and organized at all times so the campers can be as independent as possible.

Free Time: Free period daily as assigned in personal schedule

Day Off: As assigned once a week in personal schedule
